

- Inaugural Tournament in May, 2017 at Highlands Golf Course.
 - 110 Professional golfers; \$20,000 to Winner; \$100,000 Prize Money; Long-Drive Contest for Pros
 - 30 Teams in Pro-Am Tournament
 - 27 Sponsors and “in-kind” contributors
 - Sponsor Revenue over \$65,000 with Net Proceeds of \$18,500 granted to charities and \$3,500 retained for 2018 Tournament
 - Charity participants for 2017 were Boys & Girls Club of Benton County, The First Tee of NWA, Bella Vista Village House and Bella Vista Animal Shelter

 - Sponsor Revenue over \$85,000 including \$7,400 from Silent Auction with Net Proceeds of \$29,000 granted to charities and \$10,000 retained for 2019 Tournament
 - Charity participants for 2018 were Boys & Girls Club of Benton County, Bella Vista Animal Shelter, Bella Vista Village House and Bella Vista Courtesy Van.

- 2019 Tournament June 10th – 15th, 2019 at Bella Vista Country Club Golf Course
 - 127 Professional golfers and 3 amateurs; \$20,000 to Winner; \$120,000 Prize Money; Continued Long-Drive Contest for Pros
 - Junior Clinic for kids on Pro-Am Day

- Bella Vista Country Club course record set – 63 (9 under par)
 - 47 Teams in Pro-Am Tournament
 - More than 200 individuals volunteered to help with the Tournament
 - Sunrise Rotary Club participating as Associate Charity Partner assisting with sponsor solicitation and silent auction donations
 - 37 sponsors and “in-kind” contributors
 - Discover Bella Vista (A&P Commission) provided a significant grant in support of the Tournament
 - Silent Auction conducted again as part of the Pro-Am Party on Monday, June 10th – generated proceeds of \$12,400
 - Total Revenue of \$90,000 with Net Proceeds of \$35,000 granted to charities and \$15,000 retained for 2020 Tournament

- 2020 APT & WAPT Tournaments June 22nd – 27th, 2020 at Bella Vista Country Club Golf Course and Scotsdale Golf Course
 - Added WAPT women golfers; \$7,500 to Winner; 64 Women golfers (55 Pros and 9 amateurs)-foreign travel limited by Covid-19 restrictions
 - Full field of 144 Men Professional golfers (142 Pros and 2 amateurs); \$20,000 to Winner; \$130,000 Prize Money; Continued Long-Drive Contest for Men Pros and added women Pros to Long-Drive Contest
 - Capacity of 42 Teams in Pro-Am Tournament due to Covid-19 restrictions – had 42 Teams in Pro-Am
 - More than 180 individuals volunteered to help with the Tournament
 - Sunrise Rotary Club participated as Associate Charity Partner assisting with sponsor solicitation and silent auction donations

- 31 sponsors and “in-kind” contributors with contributions exceeding 2019 by over \$2,000
 - Discover Bella Vista (A&P Commission) again provided a significant grant in support of the Tournament
 - Silent Auction again held as part of the Pro-Am Party on Monday, June 22nd - generated proceeds of more than \$11,500 in spite of Covid-19 restrictions on venue capacity
 - Total Revenue of \$88,000 with Net Proceeds of \$39,000 granted to charities and \$15,000 retained for 2021 Tournament
 - Charity Participants for 2020 were the Boys & Girls Club of Benton County, Bella Vista Animal Shelter, Bella Vista Courtesy Van, and Bella Vista Community Television along with the Bella Vista Sunrise Rotary Club
- 2021 APT & WAPT Tournaments June 23rd – 26th, 2021 at Bella Vista Country Club and Highlands Golf Courses
 - WAPT again participated with 69 Women golfers; \$36,600 Prize Money; \$8,000 to Winner; Long-Drive Contest for WAPT Women
 - Full field of 134 APT Men professional golfers; \$120,000 Prize Money; \$23,000 to Winner; Long-Drive Contest for APT Men
 - 9 Amateur players in the field
 - Full field of 62 Teams in Pro-Am Tournament split between Highlands and Country Club Golf Courses, with Prizes for winning Teams for each golf course
 - More than 200 individuals volunteered to help with the Tournaments
 - More than 60 Bella Vista homes hosted almost 100 players during the Tournament
 - 33 sponsors and “in-kind” contributors with more than \$64,000 donated
 - Discover Bella Vista (A&P Commission) again provided a significant grant for the Pro-Am Tournament sponsorship

- Silent Auction held as part of the Pro-Am Party on Monday, June 21st – generated proceeds of more than \$18,500; more than 375 guests attended the Pro-Am Party
